General Information

Check-in Instructions

1. Check-in time is 3:00PM. Early check-in is allowed only when the property is cleaned and ready for occupancy. Prior approval is required.
2. You will be provided with instructions and an access code for the deadbolt on the front door once full payment is received.

Departure Instructions

1. Check out time is 11:00 AM. Please be courteous and respect the check out time - we usually have new guests arriving in the afternoon and we need all of this time to clean.
2. Please leave all remote controls and parking permits/passes at the Premises.
3. Turn off all inside and outside lights and turn the thermostat to 55 degrees.
4. Place used linens and towels in the laundry room hamper.
5. Assure all doors and windows are properly secured and locked.

Parking

1. Two parking spaces are available on the Premises (please do not park additional cars in the front driveway). Additional parking is available on East Cliff Drive.
2. Parking permits are required in the summer - two guest parking passes are provided in this binder.
3. Please do not park in a manner that obstructs the road, bike lane, or a neighbor's driveway.

Telephone

1. A telephone is provided with free local and long distance calls (U.S., Canada, and US Territories). The phone number is (831) 600-7053. You may want to note this as cell service is not reliable at the house.
2. Wireless Internet service is provided.

Hot Tub

We ask that you do some minor care of our Hot Tub during your stay:

1. Always rinse off thoroughly with water prior to entering the Hot Tub. Oils, soaps, lotions, etc. are harmful to the Hot Tub.
2. At the end of the day after your final use, please press the "clean" button and place one tablespoons of Chlorine in the Hot Tub filter compartment - it will shut off automatically.

This will ensure that the water stays clean and clear. Also, we will stop by regularly to perform maintenance and inspection of the tub.

Gardening

Please be aware that the gardener will show up once a week for mowing and maintenance. The yard is on an automatic watering system.

Trash and Recycling

The trash and recycling cans for the house are under the kitchen sink. We ask that you recycle when possible. The main trash containers are located in front of the house enclosed by the wooden gates.

Courtesy Rules

1. Please treat our house like it was your home - please use it, do not abuse it. Any missing, damaged or broken items will be deducted from your deposit. Any additional cleaning that is needed beyond our standard three hour cleaning will be deducted from your deposit.
2. Smoking is NOT permitted in the house - if smoking is detected, none of your security deposit will be returned. Feel free to smoke in the yard, however please clean up afterward.
3. Rinse off sand prior to entering the home - there is a hose in the trash bin area and an outdoor shower provided to rinse off.
4. Be courteous to the neighbors. Do not use the hot tub after 10:00pm.
5. Be mindful of noise levels. There is a noise curfew starting at 10:00pm to 8:00am. **No parties are allowed in the home.**

East Cliff Beach Oasis Pet Policy & Rules

1. Prior written permission from Owner is required for all pets. At this time, we only allow dogs at home, unless we provide written approval otherwise.
2. Pets must be kept on a leash, in a cage, or otherwise kept under control at all times. Pets should NEVER be left unattended. If you are leaving for a day and don't want to take the pet with you, you must put it in a local kennel or find alternative solutions to leaving the pet alone at the Premises.
3. Occupant and Guests must clean up after the pet. This includes properly disposing of all waste material. If any waste material is found on the property, a portion of the security deposit will not be refunded.
4. As we have a small yard, please walk your pets and let them relieve themselves in a public place.
5. Pets are not allowed on furniture. Any evidence of pets on furniture may incur extra cleaning fees.
6. All pets must have current vaccinations (including rabies). Heartworm preventative is highly recommended.
7. All pets are to be treated with Advantage or similar topical flea and tick repellent three (3) days prior to arrival. Fleas and ticks are rampant in this area and can cause harmful/fatal illness to humans and animals. All items above are the sole responsibility of the Occupant.
8. Owners assume no responsibility for illness or injury to pets while at the Premises. We are not responsible for any pets that get out of the yard.
9. Vicious, dangerous, or aggressive Pets will not be tolerated. Any such Pet with a tendency or disposition to attack other domestic animals or humans without provocation is not permitted at any time.
10. Any complaints from neighbors regarding excessive noise or other nuisances may be cause for immediate termination of the lease and forfeiture of the tenant's entire security deposit.
